

the praescutum and scutum being very short and external, but covered above by the mesothoracic scutellum, and the metathoracic scutellum and postscutellum (the latter small but distinct) internal.

The student will, perhaps, find some assistance in his investigation of this subject, by examining the highly-magnified figures contained in the four anatomical plates, published in Mr. Griffith's Translation of the Animal Kingdom, in which, for the purpose of elucidation, I have uniformly represented each of the three thoracic segments in the different orders by a different colour,—the prothorax pink, the mesothorax blue, and the metathorax yellow.
